◆ **College Entrance Exams -**

All colleges require an entrance exam. The SAT that your student took as a Junior will suffice. Please check with the college of your choice to make sure they don't require the ACT or another entrance exam. Don't be surprised if the college you choose also requests that you take a placement exam on their campus. Your student may take the exams more than once, but the SAT is only offered here at Prairie during a student's junior year.

- ◆ Please keep in mind this class is designed to give your senior tools and time they can use to help with the post-secondary decision process. It will not replace the time and effort it takes for the student and family to make such an important life and financial decision.
- ◆ Check college websites early for any **free** application windows
- ◆ Help your student study scholarships from businesses you patron and specific colleges your senior is interested in.
- ◆ Communication regarding employment, college, and scholarship information. I send emails to students regarding all of these. If parents would like to receive the same emails, please let me have your email address.
- ◆ **FAFSA** applications are available **October 1** online. You will need income tax information to complete this. Look carefully to make sure you are using the appropriate year's tax information. If student has college chosen or a few narrowed down find out when their deadline is to receive your SAR(Student Aid Report- generated from your FAFSA application). Most all your options for financial aid hinge on this report. I will send any information via email as soon as I get it.
- ◆ **Official Transcript Release - All student fees, lunch bills, uniforms turned in, etc. must be taken care of before final transcripts will be released to colleges or employers.**
- ◆ Requests for Reference Letters - Parents as busy as your students may be...please encourage them to ask their reference writers. Also, please give the writer plenty of time to write a great letter of recommendation for your student applicant.
